Institutional Site License Agreement for TCRT Online

This Institutional License Agreement is entered into this ____ (day) of ____ (month) 200__, between Adenine Press (hereinafter Adenine Press or Licensor) and _____ (hereinafter Licensee).

1. License

The License Agreement between Adenine Press and the Licensee grants the Licensee and its Authorized Users (herein after defined) a non-exclusive, non-transferable, license to search, retrieve, save, download, email, and printout copies of individual articles or other items from the database of the Technology in Cancer Research and Treatment (herein after TCRT Online, accessible at www.tcrt.org), according to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement. Adenine Press warrants that it has all rights necessary to enter into this Agreement and to make TCRT Online available to Licensee and its Authorized Users in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

2. Licensee

Licensee is defined as an educational, research, or corporate entity within a local geographical location. For example, SUNY at Albany, uptown and downtown campus constitute "one" geographical location. However, SUNY at Albany, SUNY at Buffalo, SUNY at Stony Brook and SUNY at Binghamton are separate geographical locations, and each need separate licenses, and separate print subscriptions to qualify for TCRT Online access.

3. License fee must be paid

In addition, the Licensee must pay the prevalent license fee to become an Authorized Site.

4. Authorized Site and Authorized User

An Authorized Site is simply the location where an Authorized User is, irrespective of whether on campus, or home, or away on travel for a conference. Authorized users are those individuals officially affiliated with the Licensee (see definition in 2 above) such as employees, faculty, students, visiting scientists, and other visitors to the institution.

5. Access by an Authorized User

Authorized User while on campus will access TCRT Online automatically because the IP addresses provided by the Licensee will be automatically recognized by the servers of TCRT Online. While away from campus, authorized users can login to their library and access TCRT Online.

6. What Authorized Users are Allowed to Do.

For scholarly, educational, research, or personal use any Authorized User may search, retrieve, save, download, email, and print out copies of individual articles or other items from TCRT Online. An Authorized user may display and/or link TCRT Online with educational programs such as WebCT for class room instruction.

Any Authorized User may make multiple copies of materials in TCRT Online for free distribution to students in a course. An acknowledgement like the following should appear in such materials: Reprinted with permission from: Technology in Cancer Research and Treatment (year of publication) © Adenine Press.

7. What Authorized Users are Not Allowed to Do.

Entire issues of the Journal should not be downloaded.

Items from the database should not be copied and distributed for fees

Material from the database should not be manipulated in a way to prepare derivative work without written consent of Adenine Press.

Copyright notices included in any part of the database should not be altered, removed, or modified in any way.

8. Interlibrary Loans

Interlibrary loans are limited only to the print version. The Licensee is not allowed to allow access to TCRT Online by other libraries. However, if the library is in possession of a print plus online subscription, it may download the pdf of the article, print it, and mail it to another library.

9. Unauthorized Use

An institution will not be held liable to Adenine Press for unauthorized use of TCRT Online provided such use is without the consent of the institution. If the institution becomes aware of any unauthorized use of TCRT Online, it will promptly notify Adenine Press, and take all reasonable steps to prevent such activities.

10. Disclaimers

The information present in TCRT Online may not be identical to what is in the corresponding print version.

TCRT Online is a great convenience and neat vehicle for faculty, students, and researchers to access information rapidly irrespective of wherever they are geographically.

Adenine Press will have no liability to any person for any loss or damage arising out of use of, or inability to use, TCRT Online.

Adenine Press shall make all reasonable efforts to make its server available to Authorized Users on a 24 hour basis, except for the down time for normal site maintenance. If access is suspended or interrupted, due to circumstances beyond Adenine’s control, the liability shall be limited to restoring access as soon as possible.

Adenine Press reserves the right to modify the terms of this agreement at any time by providing notice to institutions. Continued use of TCRT Online for more than 30 days after such notice shall constitute acceptance of such modifications.

11. Termination of License

Adenine Press may terminate this license for TCRT Online for any breach of this agreement, by providing immediate notice to the institution without termination of access, allowing the institution 30 days to resolve alleged breach. No refund will be provided upon such termination.

12. Term of Agreement

This agreement will remain active as long as the Licensee has an active subscription for the print version of TCRT.

13. Copyright

Adenine Press owns the copyright for TCRT and TCRT Online.
